8 & 13	Improve communication, get out the word on scheduled activities	In-pew solicitation of e-mail addresses on May 1 and 2, 2004 yielded over 120 e-mail addresses which are now being readied for use. Enhanced parish website at http://www.stjeromenorwalk.org went live on May 31, 2004, encompasses all essential parish activities and information, and catapults St. Jerome into the forefront of parish websites nationwide in terms of completeness and transparency.
