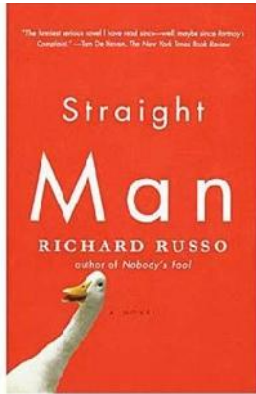
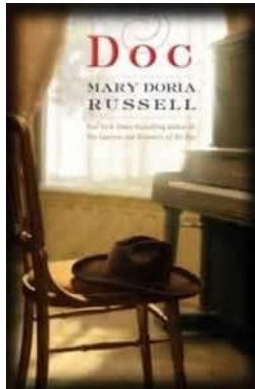


FR. MIKE BOOKCLUB SPRING 2013 BOOK LIST AND DATES

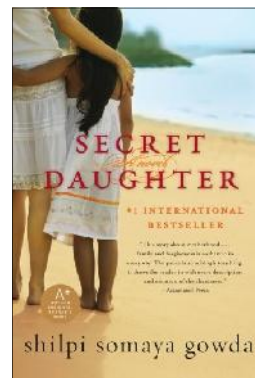

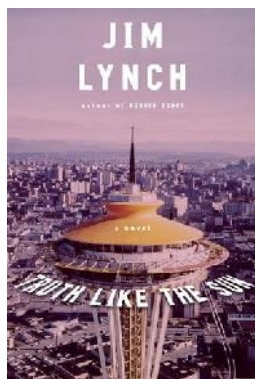
- February 21-22, **STRAIGHT MAN**, Richard Russo
In this uproarious novel William Henry Devereaux, Jr., the reluctant chairman of the English department of a badly underfunded college in the Pennsylvania rust belt, is a born anarchist and his department is more savagely divided than the Balkans.



- March 20-21, **DOC**, Maria Doria Russell
This fantastic novel about Doc Holliday and Wyatt Earp picks up the old conventions of the Wild West in a deeply sympathetic, aggressively researched, and wonderfully entertaining story.



- April 17-18, **SECRET DAUGHTER**, Shilpi Somaya Gowda
In a remote Indian village, Kavita gives birth to a baby girl, but in a culture that favors sons, the only way for Kavita to save her newborn daughter's life is to give her away. This decision haunts her and her husband for the rest of their lives, even after the arrival of their cherished son.



- May 15-16, **TRUTH LIKE THE SUN**, Jim Lynch
We meet Roger Morgan, a remarkable charmer known affectionately as "Mr. Seattle," atop the Space Needle in 1962 on the opening day of the World's Fair. With a past as cloudy as Seattle's weather, Roger is the city's "grand exalted dreamer," the father of the fair and "the city's good luck charm." 35 countries join the extravaganza, and throngs of people begin arriving to behold "the world of tomorrow today!"
