Passion/Palm Sunday

Dan will help coordinate the 9:30 AM Mass and will help with getting palms ready for both the 8:00 AM and the 9:30 AM Masses. The flow between the 8:00 AM Mass and the next Mass, the Children's liturgy, is much improved after changing the time from 9:15 to 9:30 for Passion Sunday and for Easter Sunday.

Holy Thursday

The committee reported all plans are in place for this 7:00 PM liturgy. There are three lectors, three Confirmands to hold the oils, and enough Eucharistic Ministers. There will be a cellist and homemade Eucharistic bread.

Good Friday

Jeanne was not able to attend the meeting but reported that all arrangements have been made for the 3:00 PM liturgy. Monica Harrington will cantor and there are three lectors.

Easter Vigil

Dean has completed the script for this 8:00 PM liturgy. Dan and Florence will help coordinate the preparations. Various tasks were discussed with Fr. David:

- Getting the candles ready for those attending
- Shutting off the church lights during the Blessing of the New Fire
- A letter-opener to inscribe the Easter candle
- Towels – no towels need this year because it's not a pool-type RCIA Baptism
- 2 pocket flashlights for the readings when the church is dark
- Large white cloth to drape the cross at rear of church after the liturgy.

There will be one Baptism. Fewer lectors are available than previous years, but Suzanne will make some calls to find more.

Other

Deacon Dean Finch has requested the scripts for Holy Thursday and Good Friday.
